Cruise Route

Welcome to the 12th Annual Lane Automotive Open Header Cruise. The cruise will begin in Coloma and tour to our Cruise Night Celebration, **a distance of approximately five miles**. The Watervliet, Coloma City and Coloma Township Police Departments, and the Berrien County Sheriff's Department will escort cruisers through the entire route. Local officials have once again been kind enough, and forward thinking enough, to give us permission for our cruise, and we'd like to show them that their decision was a sound one. Open Header Cruise Rules

1. All participating vehicles must have a working fire extinguisher on board. The Open Header Cruise is open to all hot rods, muscle cars, off road vehicles and race cars that can be driven for the entire cruise without overheating or running out of fuel.
2. No "burnouts" will be tolerated. Anyone doing a burnout will be ejected from the remainder of the cruise. Other than open exhausts, all other traffic rules and regulations must be adhered to for the entire cruise.
3. No alcoholic beverages or glass containers of any kind allowed. We will be on public property and roadways for the entire cruise and alcohol is illegal. The cruise will be monitored by the local police and any infractions, other than loud exhaust noise, will be dealt with accordingly.
4. The directors and event management of the Lane Automotive Open Header Cruise reserve the right to restrict entrants based upon safety issues, appearance, or personal conduct deemed objectionable. This includes unsafe equipment or any printed material on or around the vehicle which might offend someone.
5. No bicycles, scooters, mopeds, golf carts, or skateboards allowed.
6. All passengers must be contained within the passenger compartment of the cruising vehicles. No passengers will be permitted in the box of pickup trucks, etc.

Overview

Cruisers will line up at 4:00 pm at the new starting point, Coloma Lanes Bowling Alley, just off I-94 Exit 39 at Coloma. Come early and visit with a great group of car enthusiasts. The cruise will depart at 5:00 pm. A pace car will keep us at "parade speed" and we will cruise, without stop lights, for the length of the route.

Directions To Event – **New Starting Point At Coloma Lanes Bowling Alley**

From East or West via I-94: Take **Exit 39**. Turn left at the end of the off ramp and head South to the the first intersection - Mountain Road. Turn right onto Mountain Road and drive 1/4 mile to Coloma Lanes.

From the East on Red Arrow, turn left at the stoplight at the intersection of Red Arrow and S. Church Street; **from the West on Red Arrow,** turn right at S. Church Street. Continue South past McDonalds, over I-94 and to the next intersection. Turn right onto Mountain Road and drive 1/4 mile to Coloma Lanes.

Coloma Lanes is on the North side of the road. Watch for the Open Header Cruise sign.

We will begin lining up and assigning numbers at 4:00 pm. The cruise will start at 5:00 pm, head East on Mountain Road to Friday Road which becomes Church Street and then Paw Paw Street. We will cruise through downtown Coloma, then cross the Paw Paw River bridge before turning right (east) onto Paw Paw Avenue. We will continue east on Paw Paw Avenue for approximately two miles. We will then intersect M-140/North Main Street at the north end of Watervliet. Turning right, we will cruise through downtown Watervliet, continuing south to the **Lane Automotive Cruise Night Celebration**.
